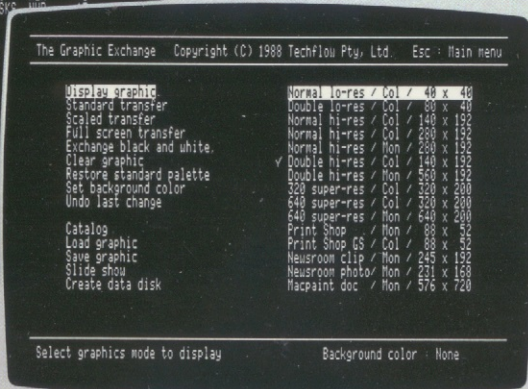
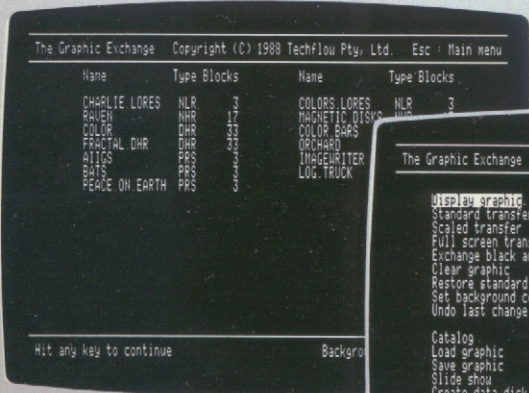

The Graphic Exchange™ !!

With every new version of the Apple® II, and new releases of graphics programs like Dazzle Draw, Print Shop, Newsroom, PaintWorks, etc., it seems like there is always a new graphics format to deal with. And, with the new format comes the problem of how to use all the old graphics with the new software.

Good news! With the Graphic Exchange™, you can now pass virtually any Apple II graphics image between different application programs. This means you can take a Print Shop graphic, and convert it to a Super Hi-Res image for use with Print Shop GS, PaintWorks, Deluxe Paint, 8/16 Paint, MultiScribe and others. You can take your favorite Newsroom art and use it in Dazzle Draw. Extract portions of any graphic screen and turn it into your own clip art.

To the right is one of the screen displays of The Graphic Exchange. The Graphic Exchange loads a picture in any of these formats, converts all or a portion of the screen (even re-scaled if you wish) to any of the other formats, and then saves the new file to disk.

You can have one picture in each of the possible formats in memory all at the same time, making it very easy to move back and forth as you convert and edit the graphics.

Colors are automatically preserved wherever possible, and you can also choose to ignore the background color when transferring an image, thus superimposing just the image you want on the destination screen.

The Graphic Exchange can directly read Macintosh disks (400K, 800K, MFS or HFS), after which the image can be converted to any of the other formats. There are literally thousands of Mac clip art images available, and this resource is now available to you with The Graphic Exchange. The Graphic Exchange cannot write to a Mac disk, but can write Mac pictures to an Apple ProDOS disk in the AFE (Apple File Exchange) format, for storage on your own 3.5" disks, hard disks, etc.

If you use Apple graphics, you can't afford to be without The Graphic Exchange!

The Graphic Exchange requires an Apple IIGS with a minimum of 768K RAM (total). It is shipped on a 3.5" disk, is not copy-protected, and is hard disk compatible.

Note: Some details will be lost when converting an image from a high-resolution mode to a lower resolution mode, but this is to be expected. However, The Graphic Exchange has been specially designed to give the best image conversion possible under all conditions.
